
1. This invitation for bids follows the general procurement notice (GPN) for Credit 4954-BD was published on 31 July, 2011 in issue Nr 803 of the UN Development Business.
2. *The Government People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) and grants from donors toward the cost of the Health, Population and Nutrition Sector development Program (HPNSDP), and it intends to apply part of the credit and grant proceeds to payments under the contract for the procurement of Injectables Contraceptive (Medroxy Progesteron Acetate-MPA) Bidding will be governed by the World Bank's eligibility rules and procedures.*
3. The Director (Logistics and Supply) and Line Director (Procurement, Storage and Supply Management), Directorate General of Family Planning, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for procurement of 07 (seven) million vials of Injectables Contraceptive (Medroxy Progesteron Acetate-MPA) through 04 (Four) sub packages of 1.75 (one point seven five) million vials each *under contract package No. GFP/FS-02/15*.
4. Bidding will be conducted through the international competitive bidding procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of goods, works and non-consulting services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guide lines. A margin of preference will be granted for the goods manufactured in Bangladesh.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from office of Director (Logistics and Supply) and Line Director (Procurement, Storage & Supply Management), Directorate General of Family Planning and inspect the bidding documents at the address given below during working days from **9 Hours Bangladesh Standard Time (BST=GMT+6 hrs.) to 17 Hours Bangladesh Standard Time (BST=GMT+6 hrs.)** up to the day before the deadline for Bid submission i.e. **16 March, 2016 and may visit www.dgfpbd.org** for information only regarding bidding document.
6. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders up-to **16 March, 2016** during office hours on submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Taka 8000.00 (Taka eight thousand) or US\$ 100.00 (USD One hundred)** up to the day before the deadline for Bid submission. The method of payment will be by pay order or bank draft from any scheduled Bank.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 11-00 Hours Bangladesh Standard Time (BST=GMT+6 hrs.) on **20 March, 2016**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at 11.45 Hours Bangladesh Standard Time (BST=GMT+6 hrs.) on **20 March, 2016**.

All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of USD for each lot shall be **USD 18000.00** (Eighteen) thousand or an equivalent amount in any freely convertible currency(s) for each lot separately. If issued from a foreign Bank, then the security must be endorsed by a scheduled Bank in Bangladesh as authentic. Bidding documents will be delivered from Logistics and Supply Unit, DGFP to the bidders or their authorized representatives

8. Technical & Financial capability is required to perform the contract (evidence to be submitted). (a) The manufacturer should have annual manufacturing capacity of four times of the offered quantities for each Lot. (b) The Bidder has successfully completed at least 01 (one) million vials Injectable Contraceptives (Medroxy progesterone Acetate - MPA) in not more than 02 contracts within last five years. (c) For each lot the Bidder at the time of bid submission should have at least the amount of liquid asset or working capital or credit facility or their combination for an amount of USD 900,000 or equivalent in any freely convertible currency(ies). (d) The Purchaser's country does require registration of MPA from the Directorate General of Drug Administration of Bangladesh (DGDA, BD) but for the imported goods the requirement of registration is relaxed at the time of bid submission. However, products offered from oversea(s) manufacturers must be registered with the National Regulatory Authority from the country of origin. The bidder have to submit the DGDA's Registration Certificate or No Objection Certificate prior to contract signing, otherwise the contract will be awarded to the next lowest responsive bidder.

9. A **pre-bid** conference will be held on **16-02-2016** in the office of the undersigned at **11-30** Hours Bangladesh Standard Time (BST=GMT+6 hrs.). All Bidders (Preferably having product knowledge) are requested to attend the conference in time.
